PARKING IN ST DAVID'S

I am grateful to Brendan Sadka who has very kindly helped to resolve the Car Parking situation at St. David's Hospital. Thank you Brendan

The new procedure that is now in operation is as follows:-

- (1) Parking must be confined to the area allocated to patient visitors
- (2) The car registration number must be accurately put into the wall tablet at the Hospital's Main Reception Desk.
- (3) This must be done within ten minutes of driving onto the Hospital site.
- (4) You have **2 hours free parking from the time of entry onto the site. If you go over that time limit or if you haven't registered within ten minutes, it is understood that the parking technology which is automated will give a penalty charge.** Two people recently incurred fines, one fine has been refunded., another is waiting for a result.

First Reading (Isaiah 58:7-10)

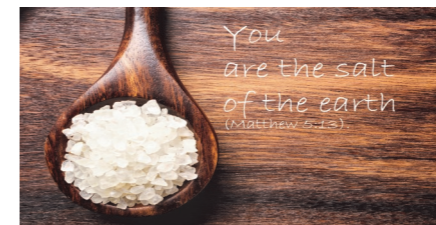
There is a saying which is familiar "When all is said and done, there's a lot more said than done". Faith, hope and charity only really come alive when they are done.

Mass for the Sick in St Mary's next Saturday

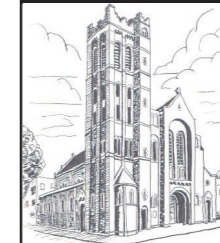
11th February at 12 noon
